- 2-Dimensional paintings, if framed, must be securely wired, or 1-1/2" or larger gallery wrap is acceptable.
- 3-Dimensional artwork heavier than 50 pounds must include a display stand.
- No artwork may be removed before completion of the show, and no artwork may be left in the building after the show has ended.
- All artworks must be picked up by 4pm, Saturday, November 9, 2024.

## **REGISTRATION AND FEES**

Entry Fee: \$15 member/\$20 non-member for one entry; \$30 member/\$35 non-member for up to 3 entries. You may enter up to 3 pieces.
